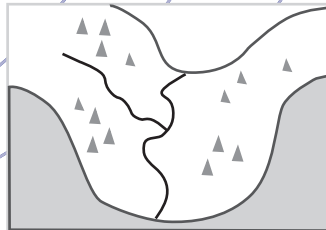


Features formed by glacial erosion

U-shaped valley



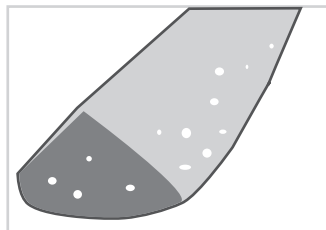
The glacier, aided by the moraine, smooths its bed thus forming this typical valley

Glacial cirque



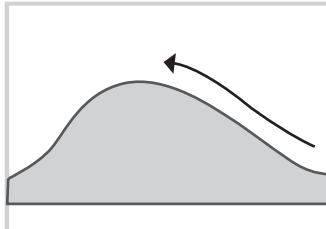
Semi circular amphitheater shaped depression between mountain summits at the head of the glacier

Moraine



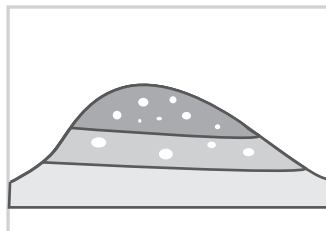
Accumulation of variously shaped rocks (smooth and otherwise), pebbles and sand deposited by the glacier

Mound



Rocky humps smoothed and striped by the action of the ice

Drumling



Elliptical hill made up of layers of morainic materials and pebbles

Erratic boulder



Large rock transported by glaciers for hundreds of kilometers and deposited far from their origin

Gigants' pot



Circular hole in the rock created by water flowing below the ice
